Introduction

Scientific innovation and technological advancement bring prosperity and comfort to lives. Yet technology alone does not guarantee a safer world. With a changing socio-economic landscape and global climate, the people in the world are increasingly vulnerable to natural disasters like typhoons, earthquakes and tsunamis, leading to nuclear and radioactive incidents, such as the recent crisis in Japan. A wide spectrum of new challenges, together with the ongoing threats of terrorist attacks and outbreaks of new infectious diseases, highlight the need for a comprehensive life-saving strategy along with well-defined monitoring systems, emergency procedures, contingency plans and coordinated engineering practices.

Effective emergency management involves interactions among different parties, such as emergency services, private sectors and volunteer organisations. It is crucial that all stakeholders are adequately trained and prepared to play their roles in a coordinated manner.

Conference Theme

"New Horizons for a Safer Society" is the main theme of "Fire Asia 2012", covering the areas of performance-based solution, engineering for safety, emergency preparedness and management of emergency services.

Architects, planners, engineers, fire and emergency services professionals are also making a collaborative effort to promote safety within their respective fields. Through the process of information and experience sharing, validated techniques and procedures, and good ideas are made known to all parties concerned striving to meet the new challenges.
