Scope of the conference

This will be the sixth in the international conference series on Advances in Steel Structures, with the first, second and third of the conferences series held in Hong Kong, fourth in Shanghai and fifth in Singapore. The first and the second conferences were held in Hong Kong with great past success. As with the five previous conferences, this conference is intended to provide a forum for discussion and dissemination by researchers, engineers and designers of recent advances in analysis, behaviour, design and construction of steel, aluminium and composite steel-concrete structures.

Presentations relating to all aspects of analysis, behaviour, design and construction of steel, aluminium, and composite steel-concrete structures will be presented in the conference by some 180 speakers from different countries arranged in the form of a single keynote presentations of 30 minutes followed by 4 parallel general session presentations with 15 minutes each. The following topics are covered in these presentations Steel Structures, Composite Construction, Mixed Construction, Aluminium Structures, Cold-Formed Steel, Columns, Beams, Beam-Columns, Frames, Connections, Space Structures, Tall Buildings, Bridges, Cable Structures, Pre-tensioned Structural Systems, Curtain Walling, Scaffolding, Roof Cladding, Silos, Tanks, Pipelines, Offshore Platforms, Chimneys, Transmission Line Towers and Masts, Design Codes, Expert Systems, Structural Stability, Stability Design, Computational Methods, Advanced Analysis, Second-order Analysis, Non-linear analysis, Performance-based Structural Design, Dynamics, Earthquake Engineering, Vibration Control, System Identification, Fatigue, Structural Optimisation, Fire Engineering, Seismic Engineering. Proceedings will be distributed to attendants registered for the 3 day attendance.
