### Scope and Objectives

As the chief editor of “Code for design of steel structures” of Mainland China (GB50017-2015), Professor L.J. Wang will give a concise introduction to the code in this seminar. Compared with GB50017-2003, many clauses have been revised and added in the new GB50017-2015 code. This lecture is mainly focused on materials, methods of analysis and seismic consideration for the new GB50017 code.

Professor SL Chan, being involved in the code of practice for structural uses of steel Hong Kong 2005 and 2010 versions, will give a discussion on the features of the 2011 version of the Code in the aspects of materials, methods of analysis and its recent applications to design of steel structures in achieving higher standard of safety and greater economy when compared with the old design methods.
